Nancy explained that raffle rules stated maximum 200 tickets sold. ("Infinite Blue" by artist Gloria Avner: 112 tickets sold, Peaceful Village 30 tickets sold). Urbn Grdn no longer wants Patrick Veillon's bell (for sale) so it will be moved to Banyan Tree by new peace bell committee member Jane Klemmer; Question remains about artist Liz Queeny's "Peaceful Village" currently on display (to move it) at Casa Mar Village. Motion was modified.
